Clare Gallery extends an open call to artists and arts organizations for exhibition proposals. Proposals may be for one-person, two-person or group or thematic exhibitions.

The mission of the Clare Gallery is to promote the arts and to allow exhibits to educate and inform all who enter our facility. Our space is visited by a broad spectrum of people. Artists are requested to keep in mind that children are among the visitors who view our exhibitions. As an urban Roman Catholic Church, we are most interested in exhibitions that emphasize world religions or interfaith themes, and social justice themes, either on a global or local level. The gallery is housed in the Franciscan Center for Urban Ministry at 285 Church Street. The Center is part of St. Patrick - St. Anthony Church, a vibrant downtown faith community.

Members of the Clare Gallery Art Committee review exhibition proposals throughout the year. Please submit the following materials with your proposal:

- *Exhibition Proposal:* Please include a description of the exhibition and its relevance to the themes presented at the Clare Gallery.
- *Websites / CDs / Photos:* Please include a minimum of 10 images that are representative of the proposed works for exhibition.
- *Biography:* Please include a resume, biography, an artist's statement regarding the artwork proposed for exhibition.
- *S.A.S.E.:* Please include a self-addressed-stamped-envelope with sufficient postage for the return of your materials.
