We are blessed to finally be able to offer more Masses for the Public .

Please note the following as we return to public Mass during this time of time of COVID-19.

1. If you happen not to feel well please do not come so as to help keep everyone else healthy. Be aware that the Sunday Mass obligation has been dispensed (relaxed) by Archbishop Blair until at least Pentecost Sunday.
2. Please keep your masks on over your mouth and nose at all times during the Mass and refrain from Congregational Singing but please do sing in your heart.
3. At the sign of peace if the friar presider does not invite an exchange of a sign of peace (he's not supposed to—per Archdiocesan regulations) you are not prevented from turning to your neighbors and offering them a Covid-safe wave of peace or other safe socially distanced gesture.
4. No Precious Blood (consecrated wine) can be distributed to ministers or the congregation per Archdiocesan rules—the presiding friar will consume himself.
5. You will notice that we have asked that you sit in every other pew. This not only provides safe social distancing but will also allow the presiding friar and a second minister to come to you for the distribution of Communion. Please stay in your pews and put out your hands when he/she comes. If you feel uncomfortable just shake your head no when the minister approaches. We can give out Communion in your hand only, not on your tongue. It is felt giving on the tongue increases the chance of transmission of the virus.
6. Upon exiting the Church, please remember to practice safe social distancing – and use all three doors for exiting
7. There will be baskets placed at the entrances of the Church to receive your offering. Thank you for your generosity.
